1] Suite Deal

From an Italian company that made its name with stylish pro-style ranges: Get one as part of a four-piece Energy Star-rated suite—a 30-inch range, vent hood, fridge, and dishwasher—all at a tasty price. From \$7,245; veronaappliances.com

2] Statement Sink

Go for the gold in a big way with this gleaming 39¼-inch-wide basin. Left alone, its "living finish" will patina with use—or seal it to protect that as-new gleam. Polished Brass Single Sink, \$1,465; devolkitchens.com

3] One Oven, Multiple Cooking Methods

Ovens that air fry are all the rage right now. This model ups the ante with the addition of a low-and-slow sous vide setting, which uses heat and airflow to deliver moist, flavorful results without the need for vacuum sealing. And it steam bakes and roasts, too. 30" Electric Double Wall Oven with Air Sous Vide, \$4,699; electrolux.com

4] Shower in Style

Black-rimmed shower doors are spiffing up baths like never before. This one gets a boost from easy-care coated glass. Unidoor Madrid Shower Door, \$1,236; dreamlineshowers.com

5] Smart Storage

One surefire way to elevate a bath: with a furniture-quality vanity made from sustainably harvested, hard-wearing white oak with sleek black metal accents. Linear 60" Bath Vanity, \$3,399; roomandboard.com

6] Double Impact

A box-shaped pull delivers twice as much metal in an open, finger-friendly design. These come in black, silver, and gold and in a range of sheens, from glossy to matte. Urban Suite Box Pulls, from \$17 each; ashleynorton.com

7] Finesse on Tap

Don't let this faucet's slim profile fool you: It's big on features, with push-button operation at the tip of the spout, a knurled base to dial in precise temperature, and a squeeze mechanism to adjust the flow. Zedra SmartControl Kitchen Faucet, \$823; grohe.us

8] Top-Tier for Less

This new dishwasher line boasts all the cleaning power of its priciest brethren for half the cost, plus an under-an-hour wash cycle, flexible baskets for more versatile loading, and even a third-rack option. 9] Multifunction Microwave

Scrapping the traditional interior turntable, this microwave uses dual convection fans to deliver bona fide baking, roasting, grilling, and air frying. Neat trick: The sleek drawer unit opens with a wave of the hand. Smart Convection Microwave Drawer Oven, \$2,500; sharpusa.com

10] Acres of Marble

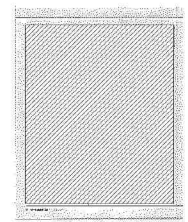

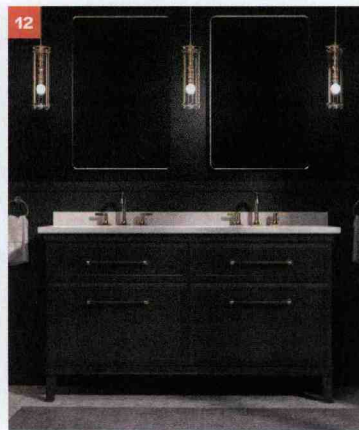
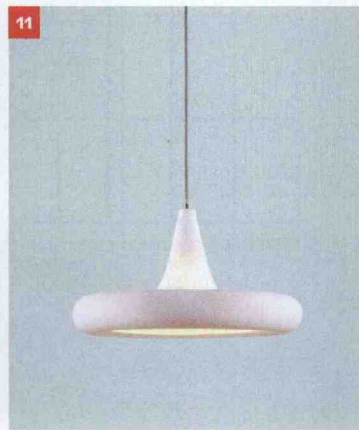
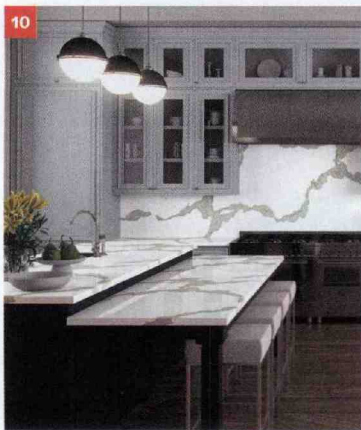
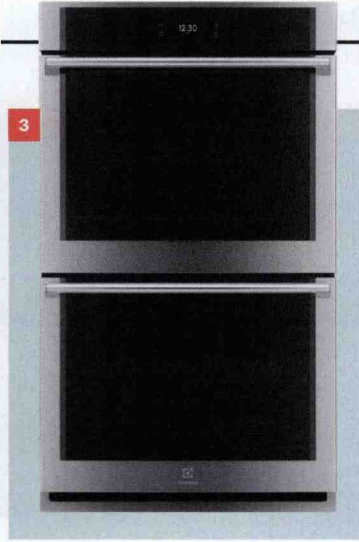
11] Winning Circle

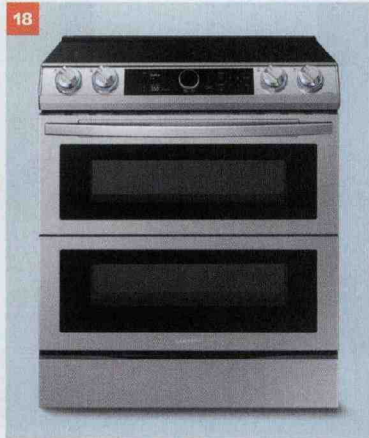
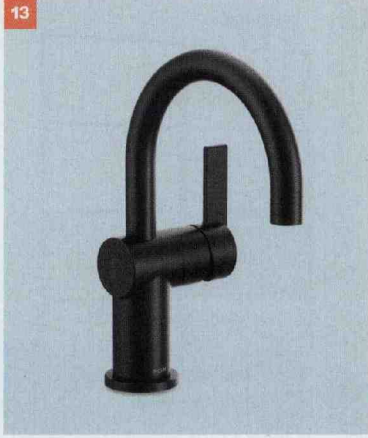
Bone china is durable, lightweight, and beautiful: in short, an ideal material for light fixtures. This sculptural pendant is left unglazed to showcase the porcelain's translucence. Drop Three Pendant, \$795; originalbtc.com

12] Hold It

Store more with this stylish all-drawer vanity with lower boxes that go a full 21 inches deep. Other pluses: its solid wood, dovetail construction and a mid-century-meets-traditional look that works almost anywhere. Harken 60" Vanity in Slate Grey, \$3,066; us.kohler.com









13] Handsome and Hands-Free

Throw clean lines a curve as you battle bathroom bacteria. This lav faucet offers the option of controlling the water flow with a wave of your hand via a sensor on the side. And its black, iron-look finish is embedded in the steel's surface, so it'll stay put no matter how hard you scrub. *Cia One-Handle High Arc Bathroom Faucet in Matte Black*, \$957; moen.com

14] Get a Good Look

Shaving? Putting on makeup? They're back, as we return to life beyond the bubble. This lit, 5x magnification mirror offers different white-light temperatures to suit different tasks. It also measures a high 90+ on the Color Rendering Index for a clear, natural image. *Lighted Wall-Mount Magnification Mirror*, \$289; robern.com

15] Make a Splash

Familiar field-tile shapes become feature-worthy in mosaic sheets with fresh colors and geometric patterns. Just the ticket to liven up a ho-hum white kitchen or bath. *Quad Collection*, from \$22 per square foot; artaic.com

16] Water Wonder

This 36-inch French door fridge, which protects perishables with its fresh air and humidity controls, amps up the pleasure of having fine drinking water on tap. Its filter removes 99.9 percent of sediment, its dispenser remembers preferred vessel size for hands-free filling, and its ice-maker can pump out up to 12 pounds of cubes daily. *500 Series Refrigerator*, \$3,099; bosch-home.com/us

17] Kitchen Toolbox

No more rummaging around drawers for the proper cooking utensil. This two-tiered maple organizer with adjustable dividers lets you arrange sections to suit your stuff. To maximize space, the two upper trays are hinged to move up and away, revealing items stored underneath. Fits 24-inch face-frame base cabinets. *Maxx Drawer*, \$364; rev-a-shelf.com

18] Two for One

No room for a double oven? This single offers two compartments that cook at two different temperatures at once—including on a no-preheat air fry setting. The induction range top has advancements, too, like an express-boil burner and app-enabled remote monitoring. *Smart Slide-In Induction Range*, \$4,099; samsung.com

19] Perfect Fit

Small yet mighty, this workstation sink measures just 15 inches square. Made of 16-gauge stainless steel, its inserts include a colander, a basket strainer, and this sapele-wood cutting board. A great solution where space is tight or as a secondary prep sink. *Siena Bar Prep RV Sink*, \$289; ruvati.com

20] Tailored to a Tee

Little things can do a lot to refresh dated bath decor: Take this sconce, which measures just over 14 inches tall and 13 inches wide. Twin tapered shades and delicate crossed-bar styling in timely black and white get a welcome warm-up from satin-finish brass accents. *Noah Shaded Vanity Light*, \$198; shadesofflight.com

21] Touchless Flush

Another weapon in the war on germs: a toilet that flushes with a wave at its sensor—which you can place wherever is most convenient for you. The ceramic body also features a fired-in surface glaze that inhibits stain- and odor-causing bacteria, mold, and mildew. *Cadet Touchless Toilet*, \$505; americanstandard-us.com

22] Bathing Beauty

Take the notion of a focal-point soaker to the next level with this copper-clad tub. Its face isn't just pretty, either: The material has natural antimicrobial properties and superior heat retention. Add in the contrasting nickel interior, and this model is a real standout. *61" Kaela Hammered Copper Pedestal Tub*, from \$3,539; signaturehardware.com

23] Steady Now

Making bath time safer for everyone at every age just makes sense. These solid brass grab bars, with concealed mounting hardware, come in a host of refined finishes and go-with-anything styles. *Deluxe Grab Bars*, from \$359; calfaucets.com

24] Loads to Love

Solve two common laundry quandaries with these well-priced high-capacity front-loaders. First, tackle serious dirt and stains with a dual-temperature power-wash feature that ramps up cleaning performance. Then defy dampness that hides in thick fabrics, pockets, and hems via the moisture-monitoring dryer. *Smart Front-Load Washer and Dryer*, \$1,399 each; maytag.com
