D / Solid brass door and cabinet hardware from **Ashley** harmonizes with virtually any style of decor. The satin brass finish adds just the right amount of depth and dimension—looking amazing in both light and dark cabinetry finishes.

So complementing a wide range of paint colors, according to the company. "Satin Brass is a great way to add a feeling of warmth to any space," says artist Karen Ashby Norton. "It is a flexible design that fits in with traditional, transitional and modern design themes."

E / The rounded shape of the Esteraceae from **Schonbek** blossoms with a gleam of polished crystals. Each stem emerging from the center of the orb is topped with a hand-finished metal floret pinned with faceted crystal spheres in the reflected light. "Esteraceae is inspired by the delicate seed pod of a sunflower," said Charles Poirier, Schonbek's founder. "The design was and is, in many ways, a nod to connect the rooms in which it's used with the natural world in an elegant way."

F / The Blaze handmade suspension lamp is composed of seven or more than 600 single hanging pendants. The pendants are made of gold-plated brass, glass and light bulbs create a blazing effect as light bursts through the small breaches of metal between them.
